

A Word From The Wise ...

Today is known as Good Shepherd Sunday because the gospel reading focusses on Jesus as the door of the sheepfold and as the good shepherd. I one of the visions of the prophet Zechariah (Zech 13:7), we read that the shepherd (the Messiah) will be struck down (killed) and the sheep scattered. Jesus allowed himself to be arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane and to be struck down. St Matthew also tells us that the sheep (the disciples) scattered (Mt 26:31).

Jesus had already said that, "after I am raised up I will go up before you into Galilee" (Mk 14:28), and this lifting refers to his crucifixion after which he told the women on Easter morning that he would meet the disciples in Galilee. Jesus is our Good Shepherd who continues to gather leads his flock and lead it to God and to the fullness of life.



THE FIRST READING

Acts 2:14, 36-41

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles.

On the day of Pentecost, Peter, standing with the Eleven, lifted up his voice and said to the multitude, "Let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made Jesus both Lord and Christ, this Jesus whom you crucified."

Now when they heard this they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brethren, what shall we do?"

And Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

"For the promise is to you and to your children and to all that are far off, every one whom the Lord our God calls to him."

And he testified with many other words and exhorted them, saying, "Save yourselves from this crooked generation."

So those who received his word were baptized, and there were added that day about three thousand souls.

He committed no sin; no guile was found on his lips. When he was reviled, he did not revile in return; when he suffered, he did not threaten; but he trusted to him who judges justly. He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed. For you were straying like sheep, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.

John 10:1-10

A reading from the holy Gospel according to John.

R. Glory be to thee, O Lord.

At that time: Jesus said, "Truly, truly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door but climbs in by another way, that man is a thief and a robber; but he who enters by the door is the shepherd of the sheep. To him the gatekeeper opens; the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. A stranger they will not follow, but they will flee from him, for they do not know the voice of strangers."

This figure Jesus used with them, but they did not understand what he was saying to them.

So Jesus again said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. All who came before me are thieves and robbers; but the sheep did not heed them. I am the door; if any one enters by me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly."

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, Begotten of his Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God; begotten, not made; Being of one substance with the Father; By whom all things were made: Who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven, (KNEEL) and was incarnate by the Holy Ghost of the Virgin Mary, and was made man: (STAND) And was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered and was buried: And the third day he rose again according to the Scriptures: And ascended into heaven, And sitteth on the right hand of the Father: And he shall come again with glory, to judge both the quick and the dead; Whose kingdom shall have no end. And I believe in the Holy Ghost, the Lord and Giver of Life, Who proceedeth from the Father and the Son; Who with the Father and the Son together is worshipped and glorified; Who spake by the prophets: And I believe one Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church: I acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins: And I look for the Resurrection of the dead: ✠ And the life of the world to come. Amen.**

All: **Amen.**

LORD'S PRAYER

Priest: As our saviour Christ hath commanded and taught us, we are bold to say: Our Father

All: **who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, And forgive us our trespasses, As we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil.**

Priest: Deliver us O Lord...

...and safe from all distress.

People: **For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, For ever and ever. Amen.**
