I will let you know if a place is available. Ascension Day is a major solemnity of Our Lord ranking with Christmas, Easter and Pentecost. My concern about getting back to attending mass has not been reduced because your level of response has not been overwhelming at this stage. 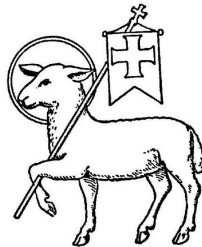

THE FIRST READING

Acts 8:5-8, 14-17

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles.

For unclean spirits came out of many who were possessed, crying with a loud voice; and many who were paralyzed or lame were healed. So there was much joy in that city.

Now when the apostles at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent to them Peter and John, who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit; for it had not yet fallen on any of them, but they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. For it is better to suffer for doing right, if that should be God's will, than for doing wrong.

Priest: I believe in one God

***All:* the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, and of all things visible and invisible. And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, Begotten of his Father before all worlds, God of God, Light of Light, very God of very God; begotten, not made; Being of one substance with the Father; By whom all things were made: Who for us men and for our salvation came down from heaven, (KNEEL) and was incarnate by the Holy Ghost of the Virgin Mary, and was made man: (STAND) And was crucified also for us under Pontius Pilate; He suffered and was buried: And the third day he rose again according to the Scriptures: And ascended into heaven, And sitteth on the right hand of the Father: And he shall come again with glory, to judge both the quick and the dead; Whose kingdom shall have no end. And I believe in the Holy Ghost, the Lord and Giver of Life, Who proceedeth from the Father and the Son; Who with the Father and the Son together is worshipped and glorified; Who spake by the prophets: And I believe one Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church: I acknowledge one baptism for the remission of sins: And I look for the Resurrection of the dead: ✠ And the life of the world to come. Amen.**

All: **Amen.**

LORD'S PRAYER

Priest: As our saviour Christ hath commanded and taught us, we are bold to say: Our Father

All: **who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy Kingdom come. Thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, And forgive us our trespasses, As we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; But deliver us from evil.**

Priest: Deliver us O Lord...

...and safe from all distress.

People: **For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, For ever and ever. Amen.**

Priest: O Lord Jesus Christ, who saidst to thine Apostles, Peace I leave with you; my peace I give unto you: Regard not our sins, but the faith of thy Church; and grant to her peace and unity according to thy will; who livest and reignest with the Father and the Holy Ghost, one God, world without end.
